Assurance of God's Forgiveness

Leader: There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free from the law of sin and death.

People: We did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear. We have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.

Profession of Faith

Leader:	What is faith in Jesus Christ?
People:	Faith in Jesus Christ is acknowledging the truth of everything that God has revealed in
	his Word, trusting in him, and also receiving and resting on him alone for salvation as
	he is offered to us in the gospel.
Leader:	Since we are redeemed by grace alone, through faith alone, where does this faith come
	from?
People:	All the gifts we receive from Christ we receive through the Holy Spirit, including faith
	itself.

- Leader: What do we believe about the Holy Spirit?
- People: That he is God, coeternal with the Father and the Son, and that God grants him irrevocably to all who believe.
- Leader: How does the Holy Spirit help us?
- People: The Holy Spirit convicts us of our sin, comforts us, guides us, gives us spiritual gifts and the desire to obey God; and he enables us to pray and to understand God's Word.
